Welcome to Fairhaven Golf Club. Fairhaven is not only a beautiful place to play golf, but fully lives up to its designation as a 'Championship' course originally designed by James Braid.

Professional golf at Fairhaven started back in 1934, when the course played host to the 'Penfold' Tournament. The club has hosted many 'Open Championship' Final Qualifying Competitions, when the 'Open Championship' is played at neighbouring Royal Lytham and St Annes Golf Club. The Professionals' course record of 64, was achieved by Justin Leonard in 1996, while he was playing in and leading the final qualifying rounds.

Listed in both Golf Worlds, "The Best 10 'Open Championship' Qualifying Courses", and 'Great Britain & Ireland 10 Opening Holes', and described by Peter Allis as "a real hidden gem".

Fairhaven has all the characteristics of a traditional links course, including a sand sub-soil, allowing year-round golf. There is an abundance of wildlife, including various breeds of pheasant, which can be seen strutting around the course and depicted in the Club emblem. Peace and tranquility are assured; not a road or house can be seen from the course.

The club has been privileged to host many other prestigious events, including in 1995, the Club's Centenary year, an International match between England and Spain, which featured a very promising young man by the name of Sergio Garcia.

The course is consistently maintained and presented to the highest standard and the sandy sub-soil means that perfect playing conditions can be enjoyed throughout the year, presenting a fair challenge to golfers of all abilities, with the 'risk & reward' course management elements of the game in negotiating the 128 links bunkers. All visitors are welcomed on arrival, ensuring they get the most out of their day and leave feeling they have enjoyed a very special golfing experience.

Founded in 1913 and registered as Lytham Golf Club, the course was opened with a 9 hole match between the Captain Mr James Wallace and the President and Landlord Mr J T Clifton. The course became 18 holes in 1914 but struggled to keep it's membership when the first world war broke out. The club was taken over by Lytham Urban Council in 1916 who ran it until 1923 when it returned to private status with a membership of 300 and the new Company was then called Lytham Green Drive Golf Club Ltd.

Quoted by Open Championship winners as 'a pleasant parkland course and a good test of golf for most players', Green Drive has gone from strength to strength after originally being designed by Dr Mackenzie and laid out by the great Sandy Herd, who was a professional at Huddersfield Golf Club and won the Open Championship at Hoylake in 1902. The course was later re-designed by James Steer (with a few minor changes recommended by the R & A) and is an extremely good test of golf, whilst remaining picturesque, with its wildlife, ponds and tree lined fairways. Two large practice areas have been added since 1996, with the second hole being extended and a new third hole added in 2004.

The Club has been very fortunate to have had professionals of the highest quality from the very beginning, including Mr Harold Beck (1951/82) one of the most noted club makers in the north west of England. Simon Williamson, our current PGA Professional, joined the club in 2010. Simon is a hugely experienced golf coach having worked with and studied under some of the country's leading coaches.

Simon made an instant impact on the club carrying out a total refurbishment of the Professional shop to the delight of members. Simon promises a first class professional service and can cater for all your golfing needs.
