The 'Golf World' magazine list Fairhaven in their top 10 of 'The Best 'Open Championship' Qualifying Courses' and 'Great Britain & Ireland's Best Opening Holes' lists, as well as being described by Peter Allis as "a real hidden gem". Fairhaven is not only a beautiful place to play golf, where peace and tranquility are assured, but also fully lives up to its designation as a 'Championship' course.

Inaugurated in 1895 the course was designed by James Braid, in company with JH Steer, and more recently new features, such as challenging 'traditional links' bunkers designed by Donald Steel, have further enhanced the course. At 7015 yards the par 72 championship course provides golfers of all abilities with various challenges and the opportunity, with the right positional shot, to score well, as do the par 73 'white' (6787yds) and 'yellow' (6562) courses.

The Club have hosted many 'Open Championship' Final Qualifying events, when the 'Open Championship' is played at neighbouring Royal Lytham and St Annes Golf Club. The Professionals' course record of 64 was achieved by Justin Leonard in 1996, while he was playing in and leading the final qualifying rounds. He later went on to win the 'Open Championship'. The Club has been privileged to host many other prestigious events including in 1995, the Club's Centenary year, an amateur International match between England and Spain, which featured a very promising young golfer by the name of Sergio Garcia.

2009, 2010 & 2011 saw Fairhaven host some prestigious events:

Our flagship championship, the Fairhaven Trophies, an international 72 hole scratch tournament for under 18year olds.

The Final Qualifying Round for the Ricoh Women's British Open.

The LGU 'Girls Home International Matches'.

The European Men's Seniors Team Championship.

The Astor Trophy for the LGU, which is only played every 20 years in UK with the top amateurs from Australia, New Zealand, Canada, South Africa and GB&I competing.

Future championships at Fairhaven will include the annual Fairhaven Trophies.

2012 - The R&A have selected Fairhaven to host their R&A Junior Open, when the 2012 Open Championship is played at Royal Lytham & St Annes GC.

2013 - The British Girls Amateur Championship for LGU.

Fairhaven is always maintained and presented to the highest of standards. Its well-draining sandy sub-soil means that good playing conditions can be enjoyed throughout the year, ensuring you will always enjoy a very special 'Fairhaven' golfing experience.



The Application Procedure & Fees - 1st February 2011 to 31st January 2012

All enquiries for Membership will receive a Membership Form to complete.

Candidates will be interviewed periodically.

Those deemed appropriate for Membership will have their names posted on the Club Notice Board for 21 days, after which (and assuming Council approval) they will be offered Membership.

Membership Categories:

Full: each new Full Member will pay the Full Member Yearly Subscription, currently £995 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a non-refundable Entrance Fee of £1200.

Temporary: each new Temporary Member will pay the Full Member Yearly Subscription, currently £995 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a non-refundable Entrance Fee of £500, which will be deducted from the Entrance Fee when approved transferring to Full Membership.

Country: each new Country Member will pay the Country Member Yearly Subscription, currently £430 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a non-refundable Entrance Fee of £600.

Clergy: each new Clergy Member will pay the Clergy Member Yearly Subscription, currently £439 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a non-refundable Entrance Fee of £600.

Couples: each new couple (living at the same address) pay the appropriate yearly subscription, (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a combined non-refundable Entrance Fee £2000.

Intermediate (25 - 29yrs): each new Intermediate Member will pay the Intermediate Member Yearly Subscription, currently £695 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a non-refundable Entrance Fee of £300.

Intermediate (18 - 24yrs): each new Intermediate Member will pay the Intermediate Member Yearly Subscription, currently £395 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining), plus a non-refundable Entrance Fee of £300.

Youth (15 -17yrs): each new Youth Member will pay the Youth Member Yearly Subscription, currently £290 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining). No Membership Entrance Fee.

Junior (9 - 14yrs): each new Junior Member will pay the Junior Member Yearly Subscription, currently £193 (or a pro-rata fee depending on time of joining). No Membership Entrance Fee.



Subscriptions:

These can be paid by either in full, monthly, quarterly or in half yearly instalments.

Entrance Fees:

Entrance Fees can be paid in full or spread over 1, 2 or 3 year periods.
